1. Introduction

This document represents the Cookie Policy (**the "Cookie Policy"**) applies to GPETEC LTD ("GreenPlanet", "we", "us", "our"), a Cyprus company under registration number HE 391842, being the issuing company of the GreenPlanetCoin Tokens, (**the "GPC Tokens"**) with its registered address at Arch. Makariou III, 55 Athienou, 7600 Larnaca, Cyprus.

The words "you", "your", "yours", "user" and "users" refer to anyone using the Website.

2. What are Cookies

Cookies that we use are tiny text files that can be placed on your computer or mobile device that uniquely (but anonymously) identify your browser or device. They are unable to search your computer in any way, cannot introduce viruses

to your computer and contain no personal identifying information about you (basically they are nothing to be afraid of).

3. Cookies that we use – Purpose and data they track

Our Website uses cookies to recognize you and keep track of your preferences.

This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Website and also allows us to improve it.

We use the following cookies and for the below analytical purpose:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website and are essential in order to enable you to browse our Website and use its features. The information collected by these cookies relate to the operation of our Website, for example to authenticate you securely onto our Website and to verify that you are still connected in order to keep your session stable until you sign out.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** These are cookies that allow us to evaluate the performance of our content and fix technical issues or errors on our Website. We use performance and analytics tools, including from third parties, such as Google Analytics. These cookies collect information such as the number of user visits or returning visitors to our Website. These cookies cannot be used to identify a user and are used to generate aggregate data.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are cookies that enable our Website to remember choices you make and your personal preferences such as log in details, choice of language or region in order to improve the user experience.
- **Targeting-related cookies or other technologies.** These cookies record your visit to our Website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our Website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

- **Advertising cookies.** These cookies that are used to collect information about your visit to our website, the content you have viewed, the links you have followed and information about your browser, device and your IP address.

5. Third-party cookies

The advertising networks and/or sellers that deliver ads on our website may use cookies and/or other tracking technologies to uniquely distinguish your web browser or device and keep track of information relating to serving ads on your web browser or other device. Third-party cookies may also be placed on your device by our business partners so that they can use them to advertise products and services to you elsewhere on the Internet.

6. How long will cookies stay on your device?

The amount of time a cookie stays on your device is variable: the majority of cookies expire after the end of your browsing session – others persist for longer. In online advertising you can generally expect most advertising cookies to last about one month at most (although again it varies).

7. Managing Cookies and how to opt out

You have the right to reject or withdraw your consent at any time.

If you opt out or delete cookies generated via our Website, it may not perform as it has been designed to, possibly reducing the functionality of our Website, the options available to you as well as the performance of our Website during your visit.

It is also possible to stop your browser from accepting cookies altogether by changing the cookie settings of your browser. You can usually find these settings in the “options” or “preferences” menu of your browser.
